

## SPLENDID ISOLATION

**Julia Kuhl**, known for her drawings, recently ventured into painting. The thick layering of paint in her new work is in direct contrast to her usual delicate watercolors on paper, yet one can still recognize the playful lines. The lonely peaked shapes on the small canvases suggest isolated, stubborn splendor.

**Robert Yoder** shows latest collages and paintings combined with found papers. His work provides us with a fresh take on supposedly classic techniques. First and foremost, it redefines the collage. Yoder’s precise and elegant compositions are strangers to randomness or bricolage; paper and vinyl are cut cleanly and all the elements put together systematically. The sources for his work are mostly fashion ads. The splendid fashion world is perfectly cut and newly arranged in empty white space. The glamour is still there, though isolated.
